Rules and Regulations

- 1- All drivers must wear approved helmets and safety glasses or goggles. Seat belts must be worn at all times (Compulsory).
- 2- Anyone under the influence of **Alcohol or Drugs** will not be permitted to drive.
- 3- Intentional hit on driver's side door will result in **disqualification**.
- 4- A siren will indicate START, FINISH, and EMERGENCY. All vehicles must stop and/or leave ring as directed of the official.
- 5- No standing object or mounted roof signs allowed.
- 6- There is a 90 second rule in place. Drivers must start stalled vehicles and make a hit within this time frame or be disqualified.
- 7- All vehicles must be inspected for safety prior to start of the derby. Absolutely NO after factory reinforcements will be permitted.
- 8- If a vehicle is disqualified for any reason, NO REFUND will be given.
- 9- Remove all glass, plastic ornaments, lights, and bulbs. Car must be clean of loose objects and glass. Chrome side rims and hubcaps must be removed. All trailer hitches and gas tanks must be removed.
- 10- Vehicles with electric fuel pumps must have a safety shut off switch mounted on an easy access surface such as the dash, and should be painted red and labeled 'FUEL SHUT OFF'.
- 11- Cooling system- water only; NO ANTIFREEZE
- 12- No wheel weights on *rims*.
- 13- No tires beyond 8-ply. They must be D.O.T. approved. No industrial, fork lifts or sand tires allowed. Passenger tires only. Up to 15 inch but can be light truck tires. Studded tire are Prohibited. No fluids or chemicals allowed in tires.
